what a great word... *extravaganza*...with three exclamation points. i'm excited just looking at it, aren't you?

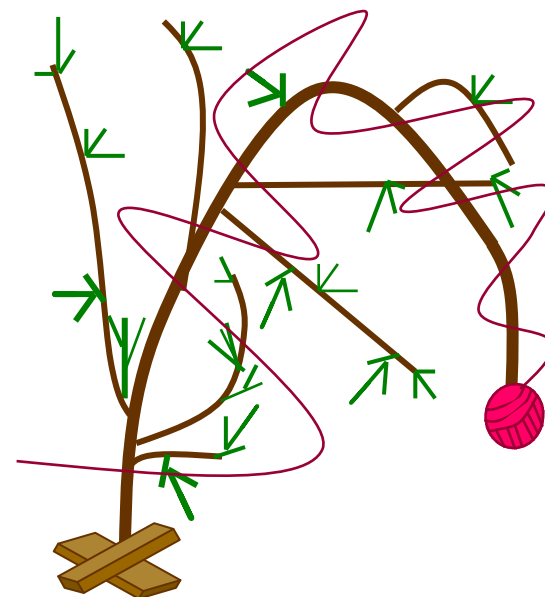
